Enrollment /Areas of study NOT available to exchange students	<p>Extension and Outreach courses, for which tuition is paid to the outreach units at particular departments instead of OSU. Exchange students can take such courses, but have to pay the full international tuition and fees themselves. <u>This includes on-line classes, except for sections 500.</u></p> <p><u>J-1 visa status students are allowed to take only one (1) on-line classes (section 500). Technology fee will be charged for this class, for which the student will be responsible on his/her own.</u></p> <p>NOT Available: 1. School of Veterinary Medicine, 2. Master’s degrees, 3. Music</p> <p>Limited: 1. Architecture (very selective! Students have to submit a portfolio of their work and a complete transcript translated into English with course descriptions; TOEFL is preferred for Architecture exchange students rather than just English Language Evaluation) 2. Art 3. Education 4. Engineering (very limited!) 5. Theatre (OSU students have preference when enrolling into classes form these majors) 6. Accounting (required test prior to enrolment).</p>

Language requirements	<p>Undergraduate</p> <p>Undergraduate exchange students are not required to submit a TOEFL score if they have a letter from their coordinator or from an English language instructor verifying their level of English language fluency is adequate to successfully complete courses in English. It should be equivalent to:</p> <p>Official TOEFL Examination – internet based score of 61 or higher</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Computer based score of 173 or higher</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Paper based score of 500 or higher</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Official IELTS Examination, Score ≥ 6.0</p> <p>Graduate – MUST SUBMIT</p> <p>Official TOEFL Examination of 79 or higher</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Computer based score of 213 or higher</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Paper based score of 550 or higher</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Official IELTS Examination, Score ≥ 6.5</p>
